Precision Rifle Qualification Course



Target: ILEA Precision Rifle Target

Ammunition: 10 rounds; begin with 4 rounds loaded into the magazine with an empty chamber.

Scoring: 90 points required to pass; 10 points per hit in the designated scoring areas.

Stage 1: 100-yard line – 1 round – 30 seconds

The shooter will begin standing with their rifle and all support gear in hand; the rifle must have an empty chamber, 4 rounds in the magazine, and the bolt closed with the safety engaged.

On command, the shooter will drop to a supported prone position and fire 1 round into the 2" circle in 30 seconds. After firing, the shooter will cycle another round, then either engage the mechanical safety or leave the bolt in the "up/unlocked" position. The shooter will leave the rifle staged and recover to standing behind the rifle.

Stage 2: 100-yard line – 3 rounds - 30 seconds

On command, the shooter will assume a prone position and fire 3 rounds into the 2" circle in 30 seconds.

Upon firing the last round, the shooter will load 1 round into the magazine of the rifle and close the bolt on an **empty** chamber, then either engage the mechanical safety or leave the bolt in the "up/unlocked" position. The shooter will leave the rifle staged and recover to standing behind the rifle.

Stage 3: 100-yard line – 1 round - 25 seconds

On command, the shooter will assume a prone position and attempt to fire an aimed shot at the 2" circle on an **empty** chamber. The shooter will then clear the malfunction, chamber a round, and fire 1 round into the 2" circle, all in 25 seconds. After firing, the shooter will load 4 rounds into the magazine, then leave the bolt open and recover to the standing position; if the shooter is using a semi-automatic weapon, the bolt can be closed on an empty chamber with the safety engaged.

Stage 4: 100-yard line – 4 rounds – 50 seconds

The shooter will retrieve the rifle and any support gear from the ground and stand two steps from a barricade with the rifle and all support gear in hand.

On command, the shooter will build a supported barricade position and fire 4 rounds into the 4" x 6" rectangle, all in 50 seconds. The use of a prone position or a bipod on the ground are not allowed, but there are no restrictions on what may be used as a barricade (e.g. tripod, vehicle, etc.). Upon firing the last round, the shooter will load the remaining round into the magazine, then close the bolt on an **empty** chamber and recover to standing with all support gear in hand.

Stage 5: 100-yard line – 1 round – 50 seconds

On command, the shooter will sprint from the 100-yard line to the 25-yard line, build a shooting position, and fire 1 round into the 1" square, all in 50 seconds. The shot must at least break the ink line to count. A prone position or the use of a grounded bipod are not permitted, but barricades or external supports are allowed.

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
