



IOWA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY PATROL RIFLE QUALIFICATION



Target: ILEA-QTT-V2 or FBI-style “Q” target; a chest box should be printed and attached to the target as high as possible while keeping the paper entirely inside the Q.

Ammunition: 2 magazines loaded 12 & 12; 1 pistol loaded with 1 round

Scoring: 4 points per hit inside the grey box labeled “4” or the head box, 3 points per hit inside the white outer boxes labeled “3”, and 2 points for all other hits inside the Q. Passing score 80 points.

Instructor Standard: Hits below the dotted line count as 0; Passing score 90 points

STAGE I: 50-Yard Line – 10 rounds – 45 seconds

The shooter will make the rifle cruiser-ready, then stand at the ready-gun position with the weapon on “safe”. On command, the shooter will charge the action and fire 2 rounds standing unsupported, 2 rounds kneeling unsupported, 2 rounds prone, 2 rounds kneeling (optional barricade), and 2 rounds standing (optional barricade), all in 45 seconds. The shooter must place the selector on “safe” during every position change. After firing the final round, the shooter will place the weapon on “safe”.

STAGE II: 25-Yard Line – 4 rounds – 10 seconds

The shooter will proceed to the 25-yard line with a loaded weapon, then stand at the ready-gun position with the weapon on “safe”. On command, the shooter will fire 2 rounds, conduct a reload, and fire 2 additional rounds, all in 10 seconds. After firing the final round, the shooter will place the weapon on “safe”.

STAGE III: 15-Yard Line – 6 rounds – 4 seconds

The shooter will proceed to the 15-yard line with a loaded weapon, then stand at the ready-gun position with the weapon on “safe”. On command, the shooter will fire 6 rounds from the standing position in 4 seconds. After firing the final round, the shooter will place the weapon on “safe”.

STAGE IV: 7-Yard Line – 3 rounds – 2 seconds

The shooter will proceed forward to the 7-yard line with a loaded weapon, then stand at the ready-gun position with the weapon on “safe”. On command, the shooter will fire 2 rounds to the body and 1 round to the head of the target in 2 seconds, then return to ready gun and place the weapon on “safe”. Shots to the head must hit above or break the neck line to count.

STAGE V: 7-Yard Line – 2 rounds (1 rifle and 1 pistol) – 4 seconds

Verify that there is 1 rifle round in the chamber with an empty magazine inserted, then stand at the ready-gun position with the weapon on “safe”. On command, the shooter will fire 1 round with the rifle, attempt to fire a 2nd round, transition to the pistol, and fire 1 pistol round, all in 4 seconds.

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
