

18 USC 926C (LEOSA/HR218): Carrying of concealed firearms by qualified law enforcement officers

For qualifying retired law enforcement officers under 18 USC 926C (LEOSA/HR218), please refer to the following:

- 1. The questionnaire must be completed by the former agency and signed by the former hiring authority, to be submitted at the time of qualification. In order to verify that an individual is eligible to qualify under HR218, ILEA must receive proof that the individual left employment in good standing via the questionnaire.
- 2. Individuals administering the qualification must be a current, active ILEA approved Firearms instructor.
- 3. The qualified individual must be given an ILEA approved HR218 card, found on the Acadis portal document library, with the date and signature of the instructor. These cards are designed to be printed on Avery 8870 Business Cards.
- 4. A copy of the signed questionnaire and the signed HR218 cards must be submitted to ILEA (scanned and sent to Kathryn.fukuda@iowa.gov) by the card recipient within 72 hours of the qualification. Because ILEA is the entity officially qualifying individuals, all cards given must be tracked in the system for record keeping.
