# 18 USC 926C (LEOSA/HR218): Carrying of concealed firearms by qualified retired law enforcement officers

For qualifying retired law enforcement officers under 18 USC 926C (LEOSA/HR218), please refer to the following process:

- Part 1 of the questionnaire must be completed by the former <u>agency administrator</u> and submitted to ILEA at the time of initial HR218 qualification. In order to confirm that an individual is eligible to qualify under HR218, ILEA must receive verification that the individual left employment in good standing via the questionnaire.
  - a. If you have official documentation, such as a letter or photo identification, stating you are a qualified retired LEO, a copy of that documentation may be accepted in lieu of Part 1 of the questionnaire.
- Part 2 of the questionnaire must be completed by the individual seeking to be qualified and submitted to ILEA at the time of <u>each</u> qualification.
- Qualifications must be administered by a current, active ILEA approved Firearms instructor or HR 218 instructor. The ILEA off-duty/LEOSA and Handgun Qualification courses of fire are approved to meet HR218 requirements.
- 4. Upon a successful qualification, the instructor or individual must submit to ILEA (scanned and sent to <u>kathryn.fukuda@iowa.gov</u>) Part 1, if needed, Part 2, and the approved documentation of the successful qualification score, ILEA will update internal records to reflect HR218 **compliance for one year**. Instructors can access HR218 cards through the Acadis portal document library to sign and provide to successful qualifiers. The agency can create and use their own cards if they so desire.
- 5. ILEA must receive Part 1 (or acceptable alternative in 1a), Part 2, and documentation of successful qualification in order to update internal records. Failure to provide the required documentation to ILEA will result in the HR218 card being voided.
