



ON CAMP DODGE, WE RENDER PROPER HONORS TO THE U.S. FLAG

Proper Honors:

The following flag etiquette guidance is to be followed by all personnel on Camp Dodge, whether Servicemember, retiree, civilian, or family member.

Reveille: 7 a.m. (0700)

Military personnel in uniform, whether in formation or in a group: The senior person brings the group to "attention" and "present arms" during "Reveille." Hold salute until the last note of "Reveille" is sounded. When music stops, formation is then brought to order arms.

Military personnel in uniform, not in formation or a group: Stop, face the flag (or in direction of the music), come to attention, and present arms during "Reveille." When the music stops, come to order arms and carry on.

Military or civilian personnel in civilian clothes: Stop, remove headgear (if necessary), face the flag (or in direction of the music), come to attention and place right hand over heart. When music stops, continue on your way.

All personnel in vehicles: Stop in a safe area, exit your vehicle, face the flag (or in direction of the music) and render honors as described above. In a group in a military vehicle, or on a bus, only the senior occupant exits and renders honors.

Retreat: 5 p.m. (1700)

Military personnel in uniform, in formation or in a group: The senior person brings the unit to attention and parade rest on the first note of "Retreat." On the last note of "Retreat," bring unit to attention and present arms. Hold salute until the last note of "To the Colors." When the music stops, the formation is brought to order arms and will then carry on.

Military personnel in uniform, not in formation or a group: Stop, face the flag (or direction of the music) and come to attention during "Retreat." At the first note of "To the Colors," present arms and hold your salute. When the music stops, come to order arms and carry on.

Military or civilian personnel in civilian clothes: Stop, remove headgear (if necessary), face the flag (or direction of the music) and come to attention during "Retreat." At the first note of "To the Colors," place your right hand over your heart. When the music stops, continue on your way.

All personnel in vehicles: Stop in a safe area, exit your vehicle, face the flag (or the direction of the music) and render honors as described above. In a group in a military vehicle, or on a bus, only the senior occupant exits and renders honors.

In accordance with the National Defense Authorization Act 2008, Section 594, military personnel, including veterans, who are not in uniform, may render a hand salute during the raising or lowering of the National (U.S.) Flag at Reveille and Retreat.
