

# IOWA LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY

## Regulatory Plan for Fiscal Year 2022 July 1, 2021

Executive Order Number Nine requires each state agency to submit an annual Regulatory Plan detailing foreseeable rulemaking initiatives for the upcoming fiscal year that the agency reasonably expects to issue in proposed or final form.

### **Regulatory Action:**

**Legislative Action:** The Iowa Law Enforcement Academy's administrative rules generally do not require updates and changes throughout a fiscal year. However, the Academy does act quickly to make changes required as a result of legislative action. As a result of the current legislative session, the Academy anticipates making the following changes to its administrative rules:

1. The Academy anticipates revisions to Chapter 11 (Salvage Vehicle Theft Examinations) to update the chapter in response to 2021 Iowa Acts, Senate File 230.
2. The Academy anticipates creating new rules as required by 2021 Iowa Acts, Senate File 342 (80F.1(21), new subsection)
3. The Academy anticipates creating new rules as required by 2021 Iowa Acts, Senate File 387. (80B.11B(4), new subsection)

### **Administrative Action:**

The Academy is committed to updating the administrative rules to reflect changes in the law enforcement and academic community. The Academy anticipates making the following changes to the rules in the future:

1. The Academy anticipates revisions to Chapter 2 (Minimum Standards for Iowa Law Enforcement Officers) to increase the number of psychological tests that may be administered as part of the hiring process and to update vision requirements.
2. The Academy anticipates revisions to Chapter 4 (Instructor Certification Criteria for Approved Regional Law Enforcement Training Facilities) to update the requirements and the process of certifying instructors for in-service training.
3. The Academy anticipates revisions to Chapter 9 (Jailer Training) update the requirements for the in-service training of jailers.
4. The Academy anticipates revisions to Chapter 10 (Reserve Peace Officers) to update the curriculum and create rules associated with the new online learning system.
