Tim Carmody called the meeting to order.

The assembled individuals recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Tim Carmody stated the proceedings are being recorded and reminded Council members that they are to abstain from participating in and/or voting on any action items involving a potential conflict of interest.

Tim Carmody began with the welcome and introductions of the Academy Council, ILEA staff and guests listed above. This included the acknowledgement of Wes Breckenridge who has taken the position of Assistant Director at ILEA effective Monday, August 16, 2021 and the introduction of Brian Endrizal who recently joined ILEA as the Defensive Tactics Instructor.

Tim Carmody determined there was a quorum.

The first item (#1\*) on the agenda was the disclosure of potential conflicts of interest on the Open Session agenda.

Tim Carmody advised that he is recusing himself from Action Item# 5.

The second item (#2\*) on the agenda was the approval of the June 3, 2021 Open Session Council Minutes. Timothy Carmody entertained a motion to accept the minutes. **Ric Martinez made a motion to accept the June 3, 2021 Open Session Council minutes. Chad Leonard seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. The Council had consensus to approve the minutes. Motion carried. 11-0**

The third item (#3\*) on the agenda was the approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Tim Carmody reviewed the items as listed on the Consent Agenda and asked the Council if there were any changes or amendments. There were none. Tim Carmody entertained a motion. **Gene Beinke made a motion to accept the Consent Agenda as presented. Jim Steinkuehler seconded the motion. An individual voice vote was taken. Tiffany Creekmur-Aye Chad Leonard-Aye, Ric Martinez-Aye, Diane Venenga-Aye, Melissa Henderson-Aye, Sadie Weekley-Aye, Gene Beinke-Aye, Jim Steinkuehler-Aye, Tim Carmody-Aye, Vicky Long Hill-Aye. Jana Abens-Aye. Motion carried 11-0.**

The fourth item (#4\*) on the agenda was Public Comment. There were none.

The fifth item (#5\*) on the agenda was the Petition for Waiver of Iowa Administrative Code Rule 501-2.1(1) on behalf of Officer Michael Brown of the Fourth Judicial District (Department of Correctional Services).

Tim Carmody recused himself from the discussion. Officer Brown explained that he is asking the Council for a waiver regarding residency. Officer Brown currently lives with his wife and children in Omaha. Officer Brown stated that he has had this type of residency as a Police Officer in Council Bluffs and was previously granted a residency waiver. He has left the Council Bluffs Police Department and is asking for the same waiver for a new job he has taken with the Fourth Judicial District (Department of Correctional Services). Officer Brown reaffirmed the hardship his family would face if the waiver is not granted. His children would have to change schools, the foster child/parent relationship his family is in would be required to change and it would negatively affect his wife's work.

Sergeant Dan Newby weighed in stating that he has two officers in this situation, but without his agency having an ordinance to allow, his agency submits petitions for waivers of the residency rule.

AAG Dixit reviewed for the Council the circumstances of Officer Brown's waiver and the criteria for granting the waiver.

Jana Abens entertained a motion. **Sadie Weekley made a motion to approve the Petition for Waiver of Iowa Administrative Code Rule 501-2.1 (1) for Officer Michael Brown of the Fourth Judicial District (Department of Correctional Services). The sixth item (#6\*) on the Agenda was a Petition for Waiver of Iowa Administrative Code Rule 501-2.1(1) on behalf of Officer Scott Fuller of the Scott County Conservation Board.

AD Krier summarized for the Council the circumstances of Scott Fuller's waiver. Officer Fuller is a retired Davenport Officer. He now lives part of the year in Florida where he has established

residency. He returns to Iowa for 6 months out of the year where he serves as a seasonal certified park ranger.

AAG Dixit reviewed for the Council the criteria for granting the waiver.

Director Roger Kean, Scott County Conservation Board, spoke to the Council sharing the seasonal nature of his operation and the difficulty that seasonal work presents in recruiting certified officers. Director Kean feels fortunate that Officer Scott Fuller is interested in a seasonal position and believes he will be great fit with his vast knowledge of the Scott County Park System and years in Iowa Law Enforcement. Director Kean is planning to seek a County-wide ordinance, but without one currently, he is asking that this waiver be granted. Director Kean reiterated the hardship in recruiting certified officers and the fact that without this waiver for Officer Scott Fuller he may end up having to hire security people rather than certified officers which is not an ideal situation for a large park system like that of Scott County.

Officer Fuller thanked the Council and shared that he looks at this as a good opportunity to continue his role in public service as well as impart his knowledge as a mentor. The hardship is, that without a waiver, Officer Fuller would lose this opportunity.

AD Krier, representing the work of the Rules Committee, presented proposed changes by chapter for each of the following;

- a. Chapter 1 (additions & removals of definitions to provide consistency in chapters)
- b. Chapter 2 (corrective lens clarification on color blindness/MMPI-2RF & MMPI-3)
- c. Chapter 4 (complete rewrite to streamline multiple instructor applications to one/online vendor applications)
- d. Chapter 7 (single word change)
- e. Chapter 9 (complete rewrite of Jail Training Standards and shuffle of sections)
- f. Chapter 10 (reworked for consistency/corrective lens clarification/Reserve training modules)
- g. Chapter 11 (re-written mostly by DOT due to new legislation)
- h. Chapter 13 (removes instructor requirements as they are now in Chapter 4)

The Council was asked to vote to approve the proposed changes allowing them to proceed to the LSA. Pending LSA approval the changes will return to the Academy Council for final approval. The proposed changes to each chapter were reviewed individually and voted upon in order.

AD Krier spoke to proposed changes in the ILEA Fee Schedule. A significant change is the addition of Short Academy Tuition. A short academy will be offered at ILEA beginning in 2022. Total tuition for the short course has been set at \$6,384.00 with one-third or \$2,128.00 charged to the candidate and one-third or \$2,128.00 charged to the agency or department. Exemptions include the department of natural resources, department of transportation and for tribal government candidates, which shall incur the total cost. Another update included recent legislation approving veterans who qualify to use their Post 911 GI Bill as a method of payment towards their portion of tuition.

Lastly, due to reduced printing expense the SFST/OWI manual has been reduced to \$75.00

**b. Personnel Update:**

AD Krier advised that an open position has been posted for an ILEA Instructor with instructional focus on Implicit Bias with tactical skills.

**c. Update on the 298<sup>th</sup> and 299<sup>th</sup> Basic Academy Class:**

AD Krier reported that both classes are set for graduation on August 20<sup>th</sup>. It was confirmed that Jim Steinkuehler will represent the Academy Council at the 11 a.m. graduation of the 298<sup>th</sup> and Tim Carmody will represent the Council at the 2 p.m. graduation of the 299<sup>th</sup>.

The next session of Basic Academy, graduating in December, will be named 300A & 300B and will graduate as one class in a special ceremony to celebrate the milestone of ILEA's 300<sup>th</sup> Basic Academy Class.

**d. Update on the Regional Academies:**

AD Krier provided an update on Regional Academies underway and upcoming, highlighting that by mid-September all 5 Regional Academies will be in session at once.

**e. Update on Reserve Academy**

AD Krier introduced Haley Nichols, ILEA eLearning Coordinator to share a brief video overviewing the look and usability of the in-process Reserve Academy Modules via Auzmor, an online learning platform. The Modules are in the final design stages and are set to go live towards the end of August.

AD Krier, assisted by Katy Fukuda, ILEA Admin II, shared a visual presentation of the also in-process new ILEA website. Some discussion was had. Vicky Long-Hill asked that multi-cultural diversity be represented in photos as often as possible.

**f. Update on Specialty Schools:**

Instructor Michelsen provided a report on specialty schools. Highlights included; FTO School in September, Basic & Advanced Chaplin in October, and Executive Leadership & Instructor Development in November. Options for a Media School are currently being researched.


