THE TELECOMMUNICATOR ADVISORY BOARD AND ILEA have been meeting to take a deep dive into the training required by Telecommunicators. We are almost done with creating a survey which will ask for your voice in how a 40 hour Basic Training looks for all new employees. ILEA will email this out in the very near future.

[EXECUTIVE ORDER 10](#): The Governor signed an Executive Order on January 10th that will implement a deliberative approach to rulemaking for agencies across the State of Iowa. It will increase public input in the rulemaking process, eliminate rules that are duplicates of the Code, decrease restrictive language, and clean up current administrative rules as a whole. This will be a long process starting in 2023 and ending in 2026. Agencies will stagger their process. Until the process for each agency is complete, there is a moratorium on rulemaking unless the rule fits into an exception from these categories:

1. Direction by Admin. Rules Committee to initiate rulemaking
2. Preclearance by Admin Rules Committee to initiate rulemaking.
3. Regulatory Analysis is completed (17A.4A)

WHAT THIS MEANS: In the upcoming year the ILEA staff will be doing a deep dive yet into the review of all Administrative rules under 501 with the voices of the Academy Council, policy advisors, and other advisory boards and committees. We are embracing this task as a great opportunity to dramatically simplify our administrative rules in alignment with Iowa Code. As we do so, we expect to find examples of needed Code changes and will present these findings to our legislative representatives. This is a big job that will take at least a year to complete, but when done should serve us with much more clarity.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES COMMITTEE UPDATE:

Effective 1/18/2023 a handful of amendments were published updating **Iowa Law Enforcement Academy Rules [501]**. These sections were amended with approval from the Academy Council:

2/1(11)—adds words “physician's assistant”

501-3.2 (80B)—Changes 20 days to 10 days for forms to be submitted to ILEA

501-3.4 (1)—Clarifies 20 hours of coursework for short academy

501-3.5(1)—takes out ‘duty assignments’ as part of coursework for basic instruction

501-4.1.(1) Instructor Designation—clarifies designations

9.1 (1), 9.1 (2), 9.2 (2) Jailer curriculum and in-service curriculum

10.1(5) clarifies sub rule 2.1(5).

10.2 (10)—adds words “physician's assistant”

****Do note that the proposal to change instructor certification experience criteria from 3 years to 18 months was NOT approved.** Rule **4.2 (1) Experience and training** stands unchanged. The decision of our lawmakers was by similar requirements in surrounding states.
